

What is Project graduation?

Project Graduation started after tragic teenage deaths and injuries from April to June of 1979 in the Oxford Hills area of Maine. Most of which were attributed to driving under the influence. The residents of the Oxford Hills wanted to find a way to prevent these tragedies in the future and created Project Graduation. It offered graduates a fun location to celebrate all night long under adult supervision and with no alcohol or drugs. The first Project Grad was held in June 1980. There were no drug or alcohol related fatalities or arrests that graduation season.

Project Graduation committees or organizations are now common in most high schools throughout the United States and many also provide an After Prom Party to promote the same principals. It is a commitment by parents and the community to conduct a great "once in a lifetime" celebration, free of alcohol, drugs and tobacco on the evening of their actual Graduation Ceremony. These events are held for graduating seniors only, so it's a special night just for them and their classmates.

While we are strongly supported by Piper USD 203 and Piper High School, we receive NO funding from either source and we are funded solely through fundraisers and donations. All school-related functions are supposed to be chemical-free, but what makes Project Graduation different is the attitude of the students. They have made a conscious decision to enjoy their graduation night without alcohol or drugs. And no other group, including parents and school personnel, can make that decision for the students. The past several years, Piper High School has boasted more than 85% of graduating students attending their Project Graduation Celebration.

To cover the cost and to provide all of the activities and prizes for our senior class of nearly 200 students, volunteers need to raise approximately \$50,000. This event is only made possible with the help of parent donations, corporate donations, and hundreds of volunteer hours. Piper Project Grad 2025 is a 501(c)3 Organization and can provide a tax receipt for all donations.
